## **BORROWING VACCINE**

VFC/WYVIP PROVIDER TRAINING SERIES



### PROGRAM POLICY

Commit to your health.

- Borrowing of vaccine should only occur when:
  - there is lack of appropriate stock vaccine (VFC or provider-purchased) due to unexpected circumstances, such as a delayed vaccine shipment or vaccine spoiled in-transit to provider.
- A provider should <u>never</u> plan to borrow from either the private stock or the VFC stock.
- Influenza vaccine cannot be borrowed.



# USING THE BORROWED VACCINE REPORT

Commit to your health.

- A PDF form that is faxed to 307-777-3615.
- Must be completed for each borrowing occurrence.
- As soon as the borrowed doses of vaccine are replaced to the appropriate vaccine stock, that date must be entered on this form.
- Reports must be submitted monthly and kept as part of the VFC program records and made available to the VFC staff during site visits.



#### BORROWED VACCINE REPORT

Commit to your health.

#### VFC/WyVIP Program Borrowed Vaccine Report

Borrowing should only occur when there is lack of appropriate stock vaccine (VFC or provider-purchased) due to unexpected circumstances, such as a delayed vaccine shipment or vaccine spoiled in-transit to provider. The provider should not plan to borrow from either the private stock or the VFC stock.

This report must be completed for each borrowing occurrence. As soon as the borrowed doses of vaccine are replaced to the appropriate vaccine stock, that date must be entered on this form. These borrowing reports must be submitted with monthly vaccine paperwork and be kept as part of the VFC program records and made available to the VFC staff during site visits.

NOTE: Influenza vaccine cannot be borrowed since there is no guarantee that the vaccine can be replaced within the same season.
