

How to Disable Password Autocomplete

Chrome

1. Launch Google Chrome.
 2. Click the **Tools** menu in the upper-right corner and select **Settings**.
 3. Click the **Show advanced settings** hyperlink.
 4. In the **Passwords and forms** section, clear the check box next to "Offer to save passwords I enter on the web."
 5. Click the Back Arrow in the top portion of the Chrome window to resume use of the browser with the settings adjusted.
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Firefox

1. Open Mozilla Firefox.
 2. In the **Tools** menu, click **Options**.
 3. Click the **Security** icon.
 4. Clear the check box next to **Remember passwords for sites**.
 5. Click **OK**.
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Internet Explorer

1. Open Internet Explorer.
 2. In the **Tools** menu, click **Internet Options**.
 3. Click the **Content tab**.
 4. In the **AutoComplete** section, click **Settings**.
 5. Clear the check box next to **User names and passwords on forms**.
 6. Click **OK**.
 7. Click **Apply** and/or **OK** again.
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Safari

1. Open Safari for Mac.
2. Click the **Safari** drop-down menu and select **Preferences**.

3. Click the **AutoFill** icon.
4. Next to **User names and passwords**, click **Edit**.
5. Click **Remove All** and then click **Done**.
6. Clear the check box next to **User names and passwords**.
7. Close the **AutoFill** window
